
RELIGION

Spirituality

a broad concept with room for many perspectives

- in general, it includes a sense of connection to something bigger than ourselves
- more of an individual practice, and has to do with having a sense of peace and purpose 'introspection'
- a process of developing beliefs around the meaning of life and connection with others, without any religious connections

Benefits

Cut out the middle-man/woman

It is an individual working on their own

Hence you will define what it means for you

Downside

- Different Views
 - ok as long as there is no proselytizing

Conflict with your religion/religious beliefs you grew up with

 Do a thing which is not quite OK but justify it with your own brand of 'spirituality' → Cults

- Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?


